

# Art, Vocabulary of the Soul Theme for the weekend: **TBA**

This is a hands-on retreat. We will spend time listening and creating. I will be specifically teaching from a pictorial art perspective, but what I teach can be applied to other types of art as well, i.e. writing, photography, poetry, dance, music, etc. I write poetry, and songs as well as paint and the spiritual process for each is very similar.

Scripture for the weekend – **\*\* to read ahead of time\*\*** to prepare your heart for the weekend. (You will receive this about 2-3 weeks prior to the retreat)

  - (*I will be bringing watercolors and acrylics if you do not have your own supplies already. \$15 will cover the supplies for the weekend for watercolor. \$25 will cover supplies for acrylics. Let me know if you need this.*)
